# Questions and Answers on your new billing plan

We recognize this is a change from your previous billing experience and are providing additional information to assist you in the transition.

# When will I receive my initial bill for the referenced policy on new billing plan?

You will receive your first bill in your renewal packet within the next 60 days. Even if you were previously on paperless billing and/or automatic recurring Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT), your first bill will be delivered via postal mail and will need to be paid according to the instructions on the Premium Payment Notice.

## What pay plan will I convert to?

We will convert your policy to the pay plan identified in the chart below.

\$299 or less	1 Pay	All
\$300 or greater	4 Pay	Motor Home, Travel Trailer
\$300 or greater	6 Pay	Motorcycle, Off-Road Vehicle, Boat, Personal Watercraft

# Will my payment be due on the same date it is currently?

No, your due date will change with the new billing plan to align with the renewal date of your policy, whether or not it did previously. Your due date for each payment after the initial payment will be based on the number of days in your new billing cycle.
